Course setter's guidance

Due to coincidences, the competitions had to be moved to Kangasniemi from Keuruu on a very short notice.

The map is from a couple of years ago and hasn't been updated much, but mostly the map is very accurate. The Frisbee baskets and throwing platforms have had some life of their own. Some of them have moved to different locations. There has been less compaction and decay of woody debris than the map suggests. The terrain has only minor differences in height (2,5m contour interval), but the rocky bottom and some denser terrain present their own challenges. In between, there is open and faster terrain.

Not only in sprints, but also in mass start races, you should be prepared for crossing courses and tight turns. Especially on the longest courses, you should be careful with the butterfly caflings and at the shooting range. Let's make the only 'wrecks' of the race only at the shooting range.

Really interesting races are expected. Good luck to everyone.
